Boarding Camp

For students with an interest in drama, (especially in the process of theatre and script development through mime/movement work) who are in rising 8th-12th grades. Our focus is ensemble development and the individual student's artistic growth. The natural surroundings act as a catalyst for creative growth and the exploration of core drama principles.



With five days of intensive training, product and performance are not the ultimate goals; self-discovery, inner motivation and directed collaboration are.

The Green River Preserve

The Green River Preserve is a magnificent 3400 -acre private wildlife preserve in the Blue Ridge Mountains south of Flat Rock, North Carolina. Camper Cabins are nestled in the woods of the base camp. Each cabin has a central bathroom with sinks and toilets and two large screened bedrooms. Each bedroom sleeps up to eight people. All cabins have twin-size bunk beds and electrical outlets. Shower houses are separate.

Camp Details

The cabins must be cleared by then but everyone will stay for an “Informance” for families & friends in the splendor of the camp setting.

Tuition is \$625 for the week.

Each cabin of seven campers will have a Jr. Staffer residing with them. Healthy, delicious meals are served family-style in the Green River dining hall, prepared by the kitchen staff. Dietary needs will be accommodated with advanced notice. Request forms will be mailed after pre-registration.

Each day begins with a physical warm-up followed by breakfast in the dining hall and cabin clean -up time. The rest of the day (split by lunch time) will be spent between dance/movement & drama classes, day hikes or class time. Dinner is preceded by swimming/canoeing/free time, and the evening is filled with rehearsal & homework time as well as traditional camp fun.
